Topic—Potions



SCIENCE

We will learn about:

- the properties of solids, liquids and gases, giving examples of each
- carrying out experiments and make systematic and careful observations.
- use recorded data to make predictions, pose new questions and suggest improvements for further enquiries

PSHE

Our topic for this half term is 'Being Me in My World'. In this unit, children will learn about the system of 'rewards and consequences' which is built upon the communal understanding of 'rights and responsibilities'. Children will also be learning about Mindfulness.

We will learn to:

- add to the next multiple of 100 and subtract to the previous multiple of 100
- compare 4-digit numbers using $<$ and $>$ and place on a number line
- find the \times and \div facts for the 6 and 9 times-table and identify patterns
- find fractions of amounts
- tell and write the time to the minute on analogue and digital clocks
- calculate time intervals

RE

We will learn to answer the question: What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right or wrong? They will focus on the meaning of the Golden Rule and its importance.
