French

We will learn:

- the days of the week
- the names of colours
- to count up to 20

PE

We will develop our skills in:

English

We will learn to:

- write a biography

Science

We will learn to:

- describe and alter how the volume and pitch of sound can change.
- recognise that sound and vibration are linked

Maths

We will learn to:

- double and halve 3 digit numbers
- identify equivalent fractions
- recognise the place value in decimals
- convert units of measurement
- draw bar charts, record and interpret information
- round 4 digit numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- multiply 3 digit numbers by 1 digit
- divide numbers with and without remainders

Music

We will learn to:

- perform using our voices and a range of instruments
- describe how music can make people feel

PSHE
