To all Parents and Carers of Chadwell, Deneholm and Stifford Clays Primary pupils:

Dear Parents/Carers,

We all hope you have had a good half term break. As it is half term, there is no Keep In Touch edition for this week but please find attached the overview of the YouTube videos to support Week Eight Home Learning at the end of this letter. Week Eight begins on Monday.

We wanted to update you on the Trust's position regarding the partial re-opening of our schools.

We have risk assessed this and plan to open for the year groups N, R, 1 and 6 over the next few weeks. Year 1 on the 10th June; Years N and R on the 15th and Year 6 on the 22nd in line with the Government asking schools to prioritise the youngest children's return. The risk assessment will be available on the Trust's website from Wednesday next week following the Trust Board Meeting.

We will begin a phased return from the 10th June following staff training, increasing the number of year groups returning in the order 1, N, R and 6 over a period of 8 days in order to ensure that we manage the return carefully and effectively.

We have taken into account the delicate balance of community transmission, risk mitigation and transmission control measures and therefore there is an absolute necessity for the incredibly strict planning arrangements we have taken and will need to continue to take in order to increase pupil numbers further as safely as possible.

Where parents have responded to the survey and indicated that they would like their child/children to return, we will be writing to you each specifically on Monday to inform you of the arrangements for your child/children.

If you have registered your child to return, please read the letter you receive on Monday really carefully as it contains important information on the times and equipment required for your child to be accommodated. As you can imagine, keeping children safe at this time is a challenge and we are depending on the cooperation of parents.

If you have indicated that you did not want your child to return but have since reconsidered this decision, or if you reconsider your decision at a later stage, the following procedures will need to be in place as we have planned to accommodate children based on the survey return and as we are working in "bubbles" of no more than 15 children to minimise the spread of COVID-19, we will need time to be able to plan to take additional children safely.

If you now wish to request for your child to return, you will need to contact the school using *only* the relevant email address below. Do not use the school closure or admin emails as your request cannot be processed via these. Please be aware that there will need to be a minimum period of five working days' notice and children will only begin on a Monday (Reception Bubble B on a Thursday) when we are able to accommodate them. We will not be able to increase numbers before the first full week after the planned first children return. For example, if

your child is in year 1, then the earliest we will be able to accommodate additional children whose parents initially chose NOT to take up the offer is Monday 22nd June. We will do our best to meet your request but this is subject to staffing levels and other factors outside of our control.


