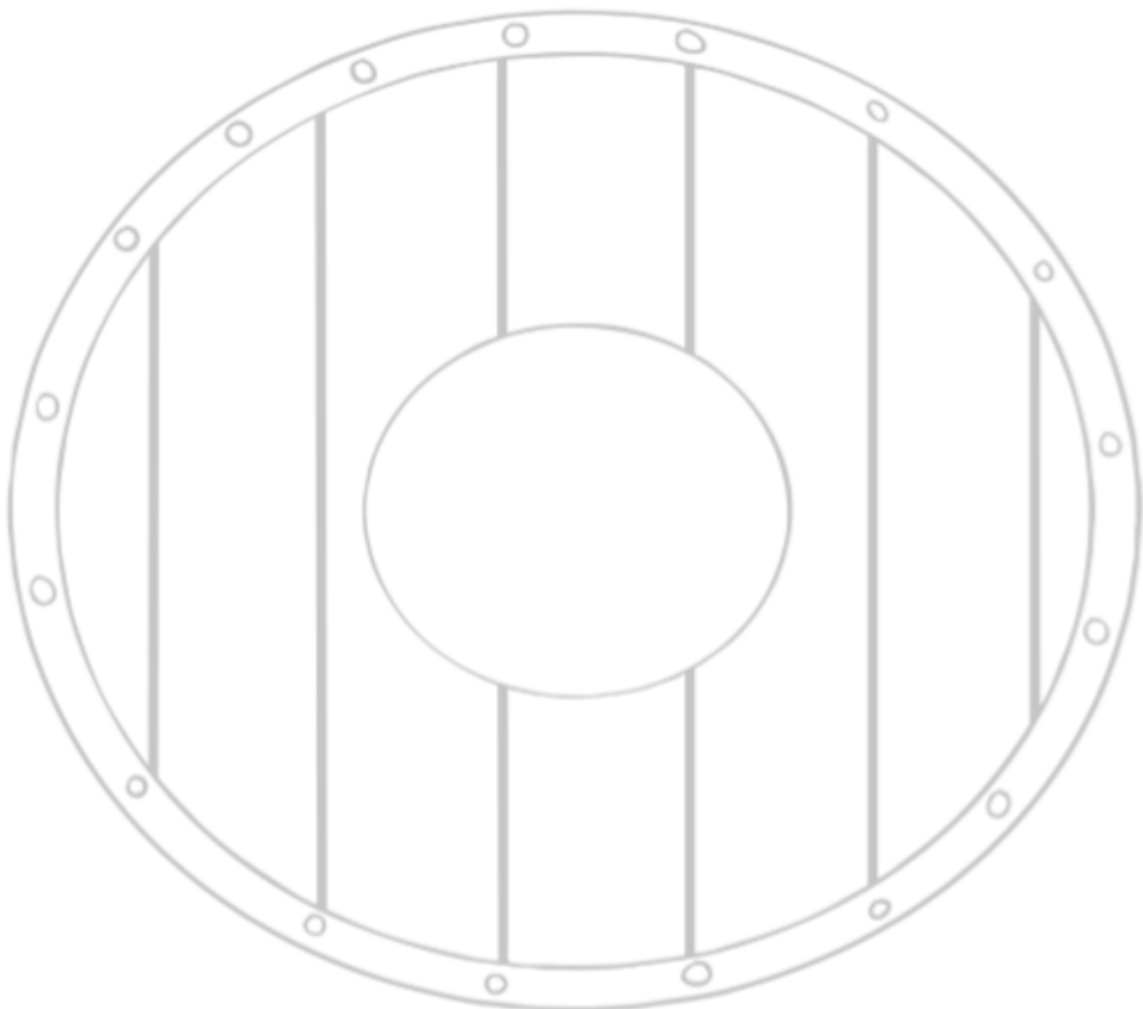


Viking Shields

Viking shields were usually made of wood, reinforced with metal bars and covered with leather. They were carried using a single hand-held grip on the back as this made it easier to move them around. The shields were about 80-90cm in diameter and were decorated in colours or patterns that were specific to the people who used them.
