<b>Reading/Phonics</b> <i>There is a YouTube video to support this week's phonics / spellings.</i> <i>Week 13 Year 2 Mrs Pillay - Spelling / phonics</i>	Reading comprehension and questions – Text: How Kangaroos Got Their Tails Time yourself for the 90 words in 1-minute challenge then answer the questions. Complete the challenge and mark your answers. Phonics – To use the suffix <b>–ment</b> accurately.
<b>Maths</b>	To use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure temperature. To read scales on a thermometer. There is a word problem and reasoning problem provided along with the answers to help you mark your work.

Week 14 Year 2 Mrs Pillay - Spelling / phonics</i>	Reading comprehension and questions – Text: Terrible Tornadoes Time yourself for the 90 words in 1-minute challenge then answer the questions. Complete the challenge and mark your answers. Phonics – To use the suffixes <b>–er</b> , <b>–est</b> and <b>–y</b> with CVCC (consonant/vowel/consonant/consonant – e.g. <b>long</b> ) words correctly.
Maths	To identify coins and add coins together, e.g. in purses and jars. There are a few challenges provided and answers to help you check your work.
Foundation lesson (to include some writing)	RE – To recognise that sacred texts contain stories which are special to many people and should be treated with respect. Read about how different groups of people treat their holy book with pride and respect. We will learn about The Bible, The Torah, The Qur’an and The Guru Granth Sahib.
