There is no expectation for your child to complete this but please encourage them if they'd like too. These challenges are linked to their topic. ### Creative homework certificates

Certificates will be given to children for the following;

Bronze - if you complete 1 piece of homework this half term.

Silver - if you complete 2 pieces of homework this half term.

Gold - if you complete 3 pieces of homework this half term.

### Menu of Creative Homework Challenge Ideas

1. Search the web or non-fiction books to find out about a famous boat or ship. Make an information book by writing down interesting facts, downloading images or making drawings.
2. Make a map of your home and local area to show all the main features. Include physical landmarks such as beaches, hills or forests, as well as human features such as shops, farms or harbours. Where would be a good place to hide treasure? Can you plot a route to find it?
3. Make a pirate treasure chest using a lidded box and other recycled materials. What will you keep in your treasure chest?
4. Write a letter to Captain Long Beard to tell him what you have been up to at school and home. You might want to invite him to visit again!
5. Make a boat to float in your bath or sink. What is a good material to make it from? Which materials are unsuitable for making the boat?
