Menu of Creative Homework Challenge Ideas

- Visit the local library or go online to find non-fiction books about predators. Look for information using contents, glossary, and index pages. Write any new facts you have learnt.
- Make your own non-fiction book about a predatory animal - maybe your pet cat or dog?
- If you could be a predator for a day, what kind of predator would you be, and why? Where would you live? What features would help you hunt, catch and kill your prey? Record your ideas.
- Devise a 'What am I?' quiz about predators to try on your friends and family.
- Make your own food chain.
- Investigate where some local predators might live.
